

ORDINANCE NO. 156-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF PELHAM, ALABAMA, HERETOFORE ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF PELHAM, ALABAMA TO ADJUST THE SEWER FEES SCHEDULE FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

WHEREAS, the City of Pelham has evaluated the cost associated with the operation, maintenance, and regulations of the sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor/Superintendent of the Utility Systems, the Pelham Water/Sewer Department, and the Pelham City Council find it necessary to adjust the Sewer Fees Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pelham has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to amend Chapter 10, Article III, Section 10-132 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Pelham, Alabama:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELHAM, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 10, Article III, Section 10-132 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Pelham, Alabama shall be and hereby is amended by deleting it in its entirety and by substituting the following therefore:

SECTION 10-132. Miscellaneous Fees Schedule.

- (a) Customers of the City of Pelham's sewer system shall pay a fee as shown, in addition to any deposit fees, impact fees, or any other costs associated with the connection as noted:

- (b) Cost incurred by the city for sampling and monitoring wastewaters shall be charged to the monitored user on an actual cost basis.
- (c) Sampling or resampling and analysis or reanalysis tasks conducted by the city to establish an industrial waste surcharge shall be charged to the monitored industry on an actual cost basis.
- (d) Flows originating outside the political jurisdiction of the city shall incur fees of service and connection as determined by the city.

SECTION 2. Each of the provisions of this ordinance is severable, and if any provision shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, in any manner, conflicting herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective on October 1, 2023.


