



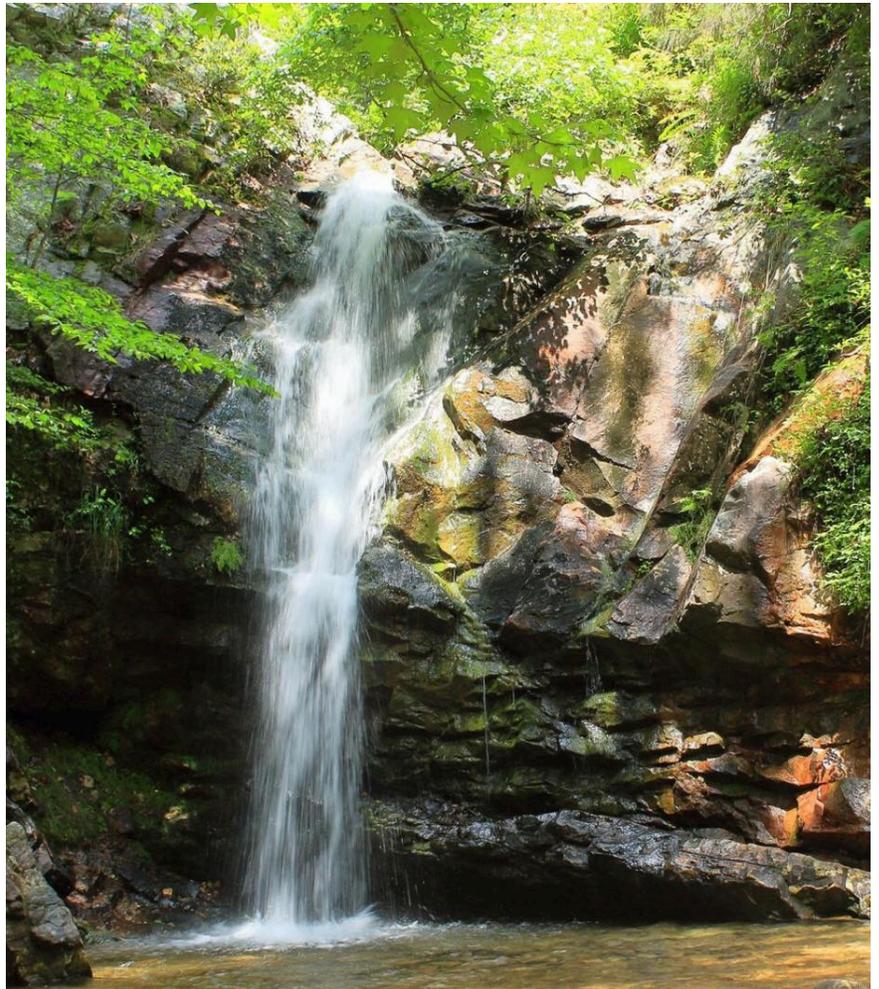

The IT Systems Analyst serves as the primary liaison between information technology and other city departments and users, with the goal of ensuring technology platforms, applications and services meet stated needs, objectives, and outcomes. This position works alongside departmental representatives, and stakeholders to support software and hardware platforms, which in turn support the lines of business performed by city departments and enables departments to provide expected outcomes to our citizens.

Ballantrae Golf Club is a favorite for residents and visitors amongst public golf courses and was recently ranked the 4th best public golf course in Alabama (Best Things Alabama).

The Pelham Civic Complex & Ice Arena is home to The Birmingham Bulls, a Southern Professional Hockey League team, and boasts two NHL-sized sheets of ice and more than 7,000 square feet of banquet space.

The Pelham Racquet Club hosts an annual United States Tennis Association Pro Circuit women's tournament that attracts top players from around the world.





# THE DEPARTMENT

The Information Technology Department provides leadership, governance, management, and modern information technology systems support to promote efficient and effective government. It seeks to encourage innovation in all that we do.

IT responsibilities include monitoring and maintaining technical infrastructure, serving our employees as customers by assisting with all technology concerns, maintaining a formal service desk system to log and manage our support services, and providing oversight and best practices for all technology efforts.

Because each action or service Pelham delivers occurs at a specific location, the IT Department maintains an authoritative Geographic Information System (GIS), which provides operational efficiency and decision-making support. Our IT team also supports cybersecurity efforts and disaster recovery to help ensure the continuity of government services.

IT's forward-looking goals include digital transformation, which includes adopting leading-edge technologies that support Pelham's strategic priorities, improve operational excellence, and drive innovation.

# THE POSITION

## ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Manages and administers application platforms throughout their life cycle, working with stakeholders and users to ensure platforms meet functional requirements and expected outcomes both for stakeholders and citizens.
- Possesses knowledge of and the aptitude to learn a range of software platforms and applications that may be assigned to including but not be limited to operating systems, enterprise resource planning, public safety computer aided dispatch and records management, document management, human resources, financial, engineering and other platforms related to the municipal government space.
- Plans, analyzes, tests, and deploys software applications, patches, releases and version upgrades; coordinate such changes with stakeholders and users to ensure successful deployment with minimal downtime or business interruptions.
- Coordinates with executives, stakeholders, and organizational staff to identify, evaluate, procure and implement application platforms that achieve business needs and successfully deliver services to citizens.
- Identifies new technology opportunities; Evaluates vendors and service providers; assist with vendor management, budget planning and procurement processes for a new technology platform and services.
- Administers and configures security and permissions for user accounts related to enterprise applications or network domains, plans security settings and roles, manages permissions across the lifecycle of a user account and the applications it is assigned to; Maintains data integrity and security across application platforms; Defines user roles and permissions; Evaluates system audit and event logs as required.
- May act as first point of contact with vendors and service providers; Access liaison between stakeholders, users and vendors; May perform root cause analysis to resolve and remedy issues.
- Works with IT staff, stakeholders, and external partners to meet federal, state and local data security and privacy requirements such as HIPAA, CJIS, PCR, etc.
- May perform 24-hour on call service as required.

# QUALIFYING CRITERIA

## EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE

Bachelor's degree in Management Information Systems, Computer Sciences, or related field and 7 years related experience; or, any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this job is required.

## CERTIFICATION/LICENSURE

Must obtain and maintain vendor required certifications for application platforms required. Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.

## OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Understands database design, database administration, as well as structured query language to the degree that allows proper support of database driven applications.
- Has functional knowledge of access control structures including user accounts, user groups and permission models for the Windows operating system.
- Has ability to present ideas and concepts to stakeholder groups and to work with such groups to train and enhance their understanding and use of technology platforms.
- Possesses excellent written communication skills, sufficient to maintain sufficient documentation, change management as well as training materials for end users.
- Hardware skills include but not limited to connecting machines to network, joining domain, and troubleshooting hardware or connectivity issues.
- Software skills include knowledge of Microsoft Operating Systems, Office Suites, Internet browsers, Database management, and the capability to learn various programs used throughout the City.
